RULES AND REGULATIONS GENERAL INFORMATION

1) ILLNESS/ INJURY/ MEDICATIONS

All chaperones will be prepared to locate a physician and/ or medical care at any time during the trip. Report any illness or injury immediately to one of the chaperones. We are very fortunate to have MS. JOHNSON, who is Calhoun's nurse, traveling with the group. There will be a first aid case in both Mr. Sardo's and Ms. Johnson's rooms if needed. All medications (BOTH PRESCRIPTION AND OTC) must be listed on the medical forms. Prescription drugs must be carried in their labeled original containers. No medications may be mixed in other bottles.

2) DRINKING/ SMOKING/ CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

No student will be permitted to drink or have in his/ her possession or room any intoxicating beverages. The same rule applies to the use of any drug, narcotic, or controlled substances, except prescribed medicine. Students are not permitted to smoke at any time during the tour. Anyone violating any law will be subject to all local law enforcement policies.

3) DRESS/ COURTESY/ CONDUCT

Since we seldom have any difficulty with our students looking presentable, it should be safe to assume that you will use common sense in your attire. As a member of the Calhoun Choral Program, you are to conduct yourself with maturity and as an example of CCP pride at all times. All students violating this Code of Conduct will be subject to the appropriate disciplinary action.

4) HOTEL REGULATIONS

- a) Phone hotel calling is limited to room-to-room. Any long distance calls must be made from the hotel pay phones. All room-to-room calling must end at curfew. Please do not make it necessary to turn off the phones in rooms. Hotel rules may vary.
- b) When moving in the hallways, please remain quiet, as we will not be the only quests.
- c) Rooms are to be kept neat, clean, and orderly at all times. If any room is unkempt the occupants of that room will not be allowed to leave until the room is cleaned.
- d) District policy states that curfew is 11:00pm unless otherwise dictated by the itinerary. CURFEW WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Rooms are to be quiet after curfew. Parents will be notified of any infraction, regardless of the hour. Security has been hired for the hotel throughout the night to ensure your child's safety.
- e) When we check into the rooms, check for damage. If it is not reported at check-in time, the students using the room will be charged for any damage found.

5) GENERAL SAFETY

- a) Students are asked to follow the "buddy system" when moving from place to place. Never go anywhere alone.
- b) When the room is unoccupied during the day, please be careful to lock your suitcase. Do not leave personal articles such as pocketbooks, wallets, jewelry or money lying around.

6) PHOTO ID

Students must carry photo ID on their person at all times. Do not pack it in your suitcase.
